Medication Minute

Elizabeth Reichert, PharmD, RPh, MSSW

Brand Name: Panacur, Safe-Guard

Generic Name: Fenbendazole

Dosage forms: Injectable, oral liquid, oral paste, granules, pellets, block

Uses: Antiparasitic (primarily used to treat pinworms in rabbits), Treatment and Prevention of E. Cuniculi

How does it work? Disrupts intracellular microtubular transport systems by binding tubulin, preventing tubulin polymerization, and inhibiting microtubule formation ultimately leading to death of adult parasites.

Dosage:

Treatment and Prevention of E. Cuniculi: 20mg/kg by mouth every 24 hours for 28 days. Single treatment course only

Routine Deworming: 20mg/kg by mouth once daily for 9 days. May be repeated 2 to 4 times per year

Side Effects: Well tolerated

Storage/Stability: Store at room temperature at or below 77degrees. Protect suspensions from freezing

Slaughter withdrawal time: 8 days

Notes: All use of Fenbendazole in rabbits is off-label
