Medication Minute

Elizabeth Reichert, PharmD, RPh, MSSW

Brand Name: Baytril

Generic Name: Enrofloxacin

Dosage forms: Tablet (chewable and non-chewable), oral solution, injectable

Uses: Broad-spectrum antibiotic, drug of choice for Pasteurella

How does it work? Fluroquinolone antibiotic, bactericidal, works by inhibiting DNA and RNA synthesis ultimately causing death in susceptible bacteria

Dosage: Pasteurella Upper Respiratory Infection: 15-20mg/kg every 12 hours for a minimum of 14 days, may be needed up to several months for chronic infection; other or unknown pathogen: 5-10mg/kg every 12 hours for 10-14 days

Notes: Injectable should not be given by mouth. The 1st dose may be given under the skin but subsequent injections should not as severe tissue reactions can occur; if under the skin injection is required, medication should be diluted to lessen chance of skin sloughing

Safety: Extra-label use, however, considered safe for long-term use in rabbits, may cause joint arthritis in juveniles. Typical side effects include nausea and diarrhea

Notes: There are no FDA approved antibiotics for use in rabbits, all antibiotic use is considered extra (off)-label, Prescription Only

****Fluroquinolone antibiotics, including Enrofloxacin, are prohibited by the FDA for use in food animals****

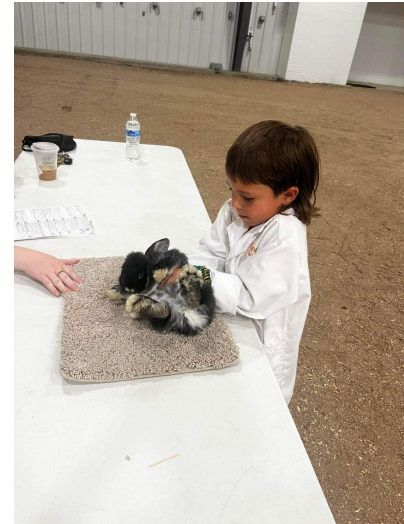
